Yes, it will. Although General Mills will receive information about the total membership's weight loss, it will not receive any individual or personally identifiable information.

Two WW offerings are available to you. You can choose the plan that fits your lifestyle.

**Offering 1: Digital** (previously referred to as Online*Plus*)

Offering 2: Digital + Workshops (previously referred to as Meetings + Online Plus)

# Who can take advantage of the WW offerings through General Mills?

Benefits eligible employees and spouse/domestic partners enrolled in General Mills medical plan who have enrolled in the My Wellbeing Program that have a BMI of 25 or greater and/or the waist circumference for males greater than 40 and less than or equal to 80, for females greater than 35 and less than or equal to 80 are eligible to participate in the General Mills My Wellbeing WW program.

If you are current WW member through General Mills and no longer meet the BMI or waist circumference requirement after completing your 2019 biometric exam you will no longer be eligible for the WW special pricing through General Mills.

If you are a current WW member through General Mills and do not complete your 2019 biometric exam you will no longer be eligible for the special pricing until you complete the biometrics in 2019 and meet the above requirements.

Workshops (which used to be called meetings) are not available in some areas in the U.S. General Mills Workshop pricing is not available the following areas:

To become a WW member, you must:

- Be at least 18 years old.
- Not be pregnant.
- Not have an active medical diagnosis of bulimia nervosa or anorexia nervosa.

## What is the cost of the WW offerings through General Mills?

Offering 1: Digital (previously referred to as Online Plus): \$8.48 per month

**Offering 2: Digital + Workshops** (previously referred to as Meetings + Online *Plus*): \$19.11 per month

State taxes will be added where applicable.

You will be charged the listed prices each month until you cancel your membership or if you are no longer eligible for the company subsidy.

# How do I take advantage of the wellness points through My Wellbeing for my WW participation?

Attend WW Workshop and/or track your food and/or activity through the mobile app or on your desktop at least four times within a three months period to receive 1,000 points.

#### How do I cancel my WW membership?

Our cancellation process is hassle-free. You can easily cancel your Digital or Digital + Workshops (previously known as Meetings + Online Plus) membership on our website. Simply log in to your account, go to "Settings," and then go to "Account" to view your cancellation options. If you would like assistance with cancelling your account, you can call 866-204-2885.
